Set against the backdrop of an uprising, following an incident involving a young man in police custody that stuns the nation, REVEALED_is written by renowned actor and emerging playwright Daniel J Carver (Royal Shakespeare Company, Belgrade Theatre).

Through the prism of a powerful and poignant family drama REVEALED offers a rich opportunity for young people to empathise with and explore issues that are relevant to today and that could otherwise be challenging themes to engage with and talk about. It is therefore targeted at those young people who may have experienced these themes, or who would benefit from understanding more about them. This will sit well as an enrichment activity alongside PSHE / RSE programmes you may already have running, and of course, exposing young people to professional drama.

Please note the age restriction is 14+, the show contains strong language and may be triggering for some young people who have experienced homophobia or racism. If you would like to view the script before attending, please find it attached / please email and request a copy.

We are happy to accommodate small groups of students or whole year groups – please do get in touch if you have any questions.
